



Board of Directors of Neurosoft S.A. approves 2014 Annual Financial Statements Results

- Consolidated revenues in 2014 to €10,27 million (€5,84 million in 2013)
- Gross profit in 2014 to €3,98 million (€2,36 million in 2013)
- Net Profit in 2014 to €2,78 million (€ 0,72) million in 2013)
- Net Financial Position as of 31 December 2014 to € 1,47 million (1,19 million as of 31 December 2013)

Iraklio, Attica, April 6th 2015 - The Board of Directors of Neurosoft S.A. met today and approved the 2014 audited consolidated financial statements, including the results for its subsidiaries, Neurosoft Cyprus and Neurosoft Romania. Neurosoft, traded on Milan's AIM Italia market ([GRS802003004](#), [Reuters NRST.MI](#), [Bloomberg NRST:IM](#)), has Integrae SIM as its Nominated Adviser.

Group turnover for the financial year of 2014 increased to Euro 10,271,403 compared to Euro 5,842,269 for financial year 2013.

"Over the last three years our profit structure has certainly become stronger as a result of significant efforts. Our main goal is to achieve sustainable growth which means growing steadily each year under any circumstances. So, once more the company's efforts resulted to increased and positive EBITDA, and net profit. Furthermore in 2014 with the merger through absorption of our subsidiary we introduced a new organizational structure made up of five nimble, focused business units allowing the company to continue product and geographical expansion" stated Nikolaos Vasilonikolidakis, Chief Executive Officer of Neurosoft.

2014 Key Financial Results

Neurosoft's consolidated revenues for 2014 amounted to € 10,27 million compared to € 5,84 million in 2013. Cost of sales for the group in 2014 amounted to € 6,29 million compared to € 3,48 million for financial year 2013. The turnover for the parent company amounted to euro € 9,06 million and for the Group amounted to € 10,27 million. The total cost of Neurosoft SA amounted to € 6,71 million in 2014 compared to € 1,54 million in 2013.

Net Profit in 2014 amounted to € 2,78 million compared to € 0,72 million for financial year 2013.
EBITDA as of 31 December 2014 for the Group amounts to € 3,11 million compared to € 1,48 million as of 31 December 2013.

EBIT as of 31 December 2014 for the Group amounts to € 2,66 million compared to € 1,09 million as of 31 December 2013.

Auditors' opinion

In our opinion, the accompanying financial statements present fairly, in all material respects, the financial position of the Group and its subsidiaries as of December 31, 2014, and of its financial performance and cash flows for the year then ended in accordance with International Financial Reporting Standards as adopted by the European Union.

Outlook

In 2014 Neurosoft demonstrated growth in each one of its areas of activity continuing to benefit from its steady and effective business plan despite the fact that 2014 is the fifth continuous year of recession and unstable economic situation both in Greece and in its market place.

In particular the outlook per business area is as follows:

1. Sports Betting & Gaming Analytics

As in 2013, this year, thanks to the customers' loyalty and the increased use of the products despite economic conditions in the markets of its customers, the company managed to significantly increase its revenues. In addition, the company continued to expand in the retail market and add new products in its sport betting portfolio.

2. Factoring and Financials

Neurosoft continued to maintain its dominant position in the Greek market even after the Banking sector consolidation in 2013 and successfully continued to be aggressively engaged in international outreach activities aiming to establish itself as a regional player in eastern Europe, FSU and the Gulf area.

3. ICT – Information & Communications Technology

The ICT department continued its sustained success by undertaking the design, implementation and support of a flagship ICT project by the Joint Venture of Impregilo and Terna for the Stavros Niarchos Foundation Cultural Center, hosting the National Library of Greece surrounded by the 170.000m² Niarchos Park. Apart from that project however, the ICT department not only retained its Support Services Contracts but also implemented other projects the most significant of which was a national Wi-Fi deployment.

4. Field Services Department

The Field Services department in 2014 achieved to broaden its portfolio of Services undertaking significant implementation and support services contracts, thus achieving the distinction of becoming the most significant subcontractor of Alcatel-Lucent in the local market. The personnel's knowhow has considerably developed allowing the department the provision of Services in technologies like Access, Transport, Microwave and IP but also non-Telecom oriented like Power and air-conditioning.

5. Security Operations

The Security Operations department was inaugurated in 2014 as a separate unit by parting itself from ICT. It focuses on Managed Security Services and targeted solutions on niche markets. The first Managed Security Services contract was signed in 2014. Additionally, significant effort was given towards growth both internally and overseas.

Neurosoft was founded in 1994 and became the first company to be floated in the AIM Italia market of the Milan Stock Exchange in 2009. As of today Integrae SIM S.p.A is Neurosoft's Nominated Adviser for the AIM Italia market.
